At the Car Show it was lovely to catch up with past families of the school and to talk with students about how they are doing now.

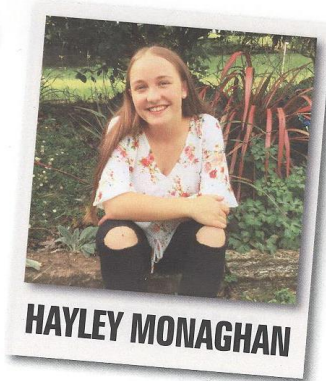

# MALAYSIAN FRIED RICE



**Ingredients:**

- 2 eggs, beaten
- 1 tsp oil
- 1 c cooked rice
- 1 c mixed frozen veges
- 1/2 Tbsp soy sauce
- 1/2 Tbsp toasted sesame seeds (optional)
- 1 – 2 Tbsp spring onions, thinly sliced

Heat pan over medium heat, add oil. Pour in beaten eggs. As eggs cook, break them into smaller pieces using a fork. Add rice when the egg is partly (70 – 80%) cooked and stir. Add mixed veges and soy sauce and gently mix. Add sesame seeds and spring onions, gently toss to coat. Serves 2.

- wholemeal pita pockets
- tomato sauce or relish
- edam cheese, grated
- ham, tomato, capsicum, onion, mushroom or spinach

**TIP:**

Place pita pockets on a baking tray and spread with the tomato sauce or relish. Sprinkle with ham, cheese, and your favourite vegetables. Grill in a hot oven until cheese is melted and golden.

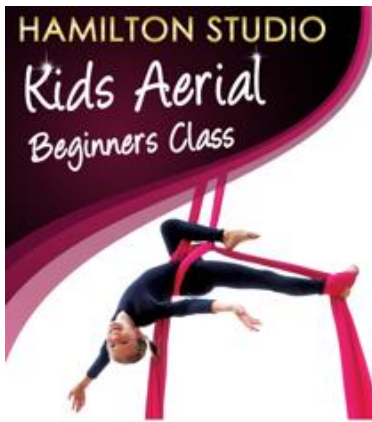
