COOL SCHOOLS

Next year we are introducing the Cool Schools Peer Mediation Programme to Rotokauri School.

Cool Schools is a whole-school proactive programme that teaches essential life skills for peaceful conflict resolution. The skills taught in this programme empower individuals to build positive, caring relationships with others, especially in times of conflict.

Staff are being trained in the holidays so that they can pass these skills on to your children.

The Cool Schools Learning areas are:

- Defining conflict
- Responses to conflict
- The role of the mediator
- The mediation process
- Problem solving and creating agreements that work
- Active listening
- Identifying and expressing feelings
- Using "I" statements
- Effective questioning
- Handling difficult situations

STRANGER DANGER

Stranger Danger

Teach your children not to talk with strangers.

Don't approach a motor vehicle for someone asking directions.

Set up a code word with your children in the event of an emergency. A friend may have to pick up your child/children somewhere other than school and you need a plan. Your child should know the code word and understand the importance. Your child should be prepared to respond to anyone who knows the code word. Make the word meaningful to your family so a real Stranger Danger would not be able to figure it out.

If a stranger does approach your child tell them to remember the license plate number of the motor vehicle and to report this information to you immediately.

Don't assume it was nothing and discount what your child has to tell you. Call your local police and report any suspicious activity.

This week I invited Chris Grace and Carl Van Den Broek from Te Rapa New World to visit our school. Over the last 3 years we have enjoyed being a part of their school sponsorship program, through which we have been able to raise over \$22,000. The program is a partnership between Te Rapa New World and our school, but it wouldn't be successful without the support of our families who continue to shop at the Te Rapa shop. All the families who are signed up to the scheme are able to earn us money just by shopping there! Every time you shop there you accumulate points by using your Fly Buys card. It is a fabulous way of making our school some money. We have put this money, as well as all of the other money raised this year by the PTA and other fundraisers, towards such things as new sports gear, the library and IT equipment. We will continue to work alongside Te Rapa New World and enjoy the fabulous relationship we have built up over the last 3 years.

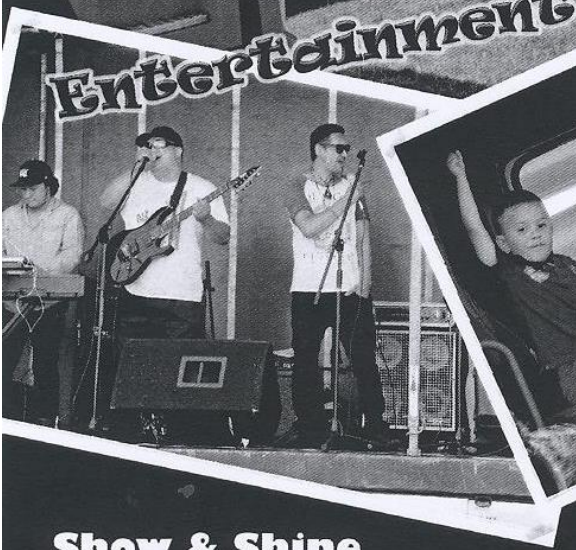
