#### Waikato Police Update

School is back, but not the same as it was! Starting Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April, the speed limit around all Hamilton primary, intermediate and secondary schools will change to 30 km/hr.

Everyone has an important part to play when it comes to road safety, particularly around schools, and this change aims to make the roads around our schools safer for all road users

When travelling near schools always remember –

- Be extra alert in case a child runs out in front of you without warning. Sometimes children can't be seen if they are behind cars so look under cars for the possibility of feet.
- Be aware that there will be children on the roads cycling to and from school. Give them space and share the road.
- The speed limit is 20 km/hr when driving past a stationary school bus and you need to reduce your speed below 30 km/hr when passing schools.

#### **Phones in Schools**

Just a reminder that from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April the mandate from the Ministry of Education officially started. No phones are allowed in schools – this includes in classrooms, at interval & lunch times, in the bus bay etc. If phones are needed please continue to hand them in to the office for the day, as this has been working well.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **Class and Portrait Photos**

Photographs will be taken on Thursday, 23 May 2024. If you would like your children photographed together please return the sibling form that is on the back of the flyer that was sent home today. This needs to be filled in, signed and returned to the school office before photo day. Family photos will not be taken without this filled in form.

After the photos a unique access key will be emailed out to you. This access key will display all the photographs of your child/ren. It is then an easy process for you to shop online and purchase the photographs you want.

Orders placed before the free delivery expiry date will be bulk printed and delivered to the school for your child to bring home.

Any orders placed after this date will be sent directly to your specified delivery address and will incur a postage and packing charge. You will see this message when you go online to view and order your photographs.

#### **Beanies**

Beanies are available from the school office at a cost of \$15.00 if you would like to buy one.

#### **Medical Requirements**

Please ensure that you come to the school office to fill out a medical form if your child requires medication during school hours. Please do not bring 3 times a day antibiotics to school as this dosage is manageable at home. If your child needs to use an inhaler please ensure that they are brought to school, named and in a sealed plastic bag. No medications can be administered without written permission.

If medication is held at school please take the time to check expiry dates and how much medication is there during the year so that, if needed, the medication will work correctly when administered.

If your child has an allergy, is asthmatic or has other medical conditions that require a health plan please let the school office know so that these plans can be completed or updated (as per the Ministry of Health regulations).
