PTA NEWS

At our PTA meeting this week we welcomed three new members – Nick Smith, Malynka McNabb and Selma Booyens.

The PTA have purchased 8 wooden shapes for use in the PMP programme and a Jump Jam Kit. Thank you.

Rotokauri School has been chosen as one of the schools in the Chartwell Shopping Centre Shop & Vote Campaign. From Monday 10th June – Sunday 7th July 2024, for every purchase made at Chartwell Shopping Centre, shoppers can submit their receipts at the customer service desk and vote for their spend to be allocated to their chosen school.

The more receipts collected, including spent at Woolworths, the more chance our school has of winning!

At the end of the campaign period, the school with the highest average spend per student (based on the school roll), will win a share of \$10,000 cash. The top three schools will receive cash prizes of \$5,000, \$3,000 and \$2,000 respectively.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Change of Clothes

Please remember to put a change of clothes in your child's bag in case they get wet or muddy while playing outside, especially in the winter months. It will save you the time of having to bring some clean clothes from home.

Beanies

Beanies are available from the school office at a cost of \$15.00 if you would like to buy one.

Medical Requirements

Please ensure that you come to the school office to fill out a medical form if your child requires medication during school hours. Please do not bring 3 times a day antibiotics to school as this dosage is manageable at home. If your child needs to use an inhaler please ensure that they are brought to school, named and in a sealed plastic bag. No medications can be administered without written permission.

If medication is held at school please take the time to check expiry dates and how much medication is there during the year so that, if needed, the medication will work correctly when administered. If your child has an allergy, is asthmatic or has other medical conditions that require a health plan please let the school office know so that these plans can be completed or updated (as per the Ministry of Health regulations).

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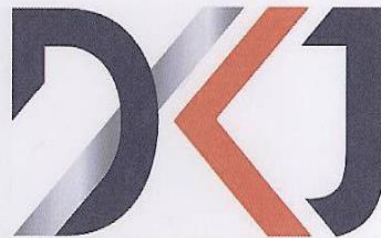
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
